Building and Grounds

Derek Johnson

1. General donations to the Capital Improvement Fund to help maintain the church's facility and grounds (driveway resurfacing, furnace and A/C maintenance or replacement, etc.)
2. Church lighting upgrade to LED bulbs to improve lighting and reduce electrical costs. (\$5,000 - \$10,000)
3. Additional outside lighting on Church building
4. A playset/playground for children. (\$23,500)

Children's Ministry

1. Walkie-talkies for teacher communication and monitoring during Sunday school.
2. Church Children's Library: Donations of new or gently used Christian books are needed, or monetary donations of any amount for these items. We would like to stock the new Children's Library with age-appropriate Christian books.
3. Donations to help fund Children's Ministry programs and to keep costs affordable for VBS. (All amounts most welcome.)
4. Three no maintenance picnic tables (recycled plastic/poly resin, etc.) to go outside on the lawn by the Education wing (about \$650 each): these will give families the opportunity to have children play on the lawn and can also be used by the fire pit.
5. Framing of the large VBS group pictures. Cost to be determined at time of order.
6. Church Library – DVDs: donations of new or gently used family DVDs or monetary donations of any amount. Note that these movies need to be Dove approved (see www.dove.org).
7. Technology in Sunday School classes: need an expert to advise CM on cool technology, modern furniture and décor to make classes inviting and friendly for each age group.
8. Portable coat racks are needed for each classroom to hold children's costumes and coats (prefer Household Essentials 3302, \$200).
9. Donations for Network 56 so we can do more fellowship events and service projects for our 5th and 6th grade children (\$300).
