

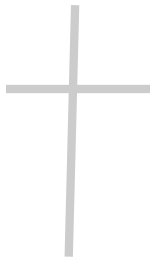

Our Campus

Our campus encompasses 11 acres and nearly 36,500 square feet of interior space.

The **interior** of our facility includes

- A main sanctuary with capacity of just under 400
- A separate chapel for small, intimate events with a seating capacity of up to 60
- A Fellowship Hall with a seating capacity of up to 190
- 15 modular classrooms on three levels
- Two fully equipped kitchens
- A nursery, toddler room, and cry room
- A dedicated music/choir rehearsal area
- 7 administrative offices, 2 conference rooms library, and brides room
- A gathering room with fireplace, 2 large lobby areas, and a staffed reception desk
- Full wheelchair access from all entrances, two elevators
- Sanctuary accommodations for wheelchairs and the hearing impaired
- 8 restroom facilities

The **exterior** of the campus includes

- 4 parking lots
- An outdoor Reflection Garden with terrace, walking paths, benches, and water feature
- 2 main entrances
- A flat, grassed, and mowed activity area
