



TEN COMMANDMENTS OF CHILD SAFETY

Ten Commandments of Child Safety

- I. Thou shall NOT be alone with a child.
II. Thou shall NOT go into a bathroom with a child. If absolutely necessary to help a child in a bathroom, 2 leaders should be present.
III. Thou SHALL practice Safe Touch rules. No touching any areas that would normally be covered by a bathing suit.
IV. Thou shall NOT require physical contact. Give choices like Hugs or High 5's.
V. Thou shall NOT drive children without express permission of their parents or guardians.
VI. Thou SHALL release children to their pickup person.
VII. Thou SHALL report all dangerous activity and/or accusations
a. To the Director of Children Ministries
b. And/or to the Children Ministries Elder.
VIII. Thou shall NOT use any corporal punishment or physical discipline.
IX. Thou shall NOT use any physical restraint or seclusion.
X. Thou SHALL use appropriate language.
